



3 Hr Training: Management Health & Safety Awareness

Aims:

This short but enjoyable course is intended to raise awareness of Managers and Supervisors of the context of H&S – why it is so important, the laws that govern our actions, and what they can do practically to take it forward within the Company.

Objectives:

By the end of the course, participants will be able to:

- Identify main causes of accidents and costs to the Company
- State the main H&S Laws that are applicable within their Company
- Recognise their own responsibilities for H&S as a Company Manager in developing and maintaining a good H&S Culture
- List the main Steps involved in Risk Assessment and be aware of some of the common pitfalls
- Construct an action plan to take H&S forward within their organisation

Costs:

£350 +VAT to train 10 persons.

Additional persons are charged at £20 per person. Maximum attendance is 16.

Travel: No charge for businesses within 30 miles from Bournemouth - otherwise mileage is charged at 40p/mile.

Notes:

All training is carried out by a Chartered H&S Practitioner and Trained Trainer.

If put on for a single company, a 'pre-meeting' is recommended in order to ensure the facilitator is aware of the H&S context within the Client's Company e.g. status of Policy, Risk Assessment etc.
