



3 Hr Training: Risk Assessment

Introduction:

Although Risk Assessment is the cornerstone of modern Health and Safety Law, many people struggle to carry them out, are confused by the terms used and find it difficult to know how much detail to put in and what can safely be left out.

Aims:

This highly interactive course aims to raise the awareness in employees of the importance of risk assessment and enable them to get involved with carrying them out at work and produce useful results.

Objectives:

By the end of the course, participants will:

- Have learned about the origins of risk assessment and the main laws applicable
- Be able to suggest appropriate controls in relation to hazards that may be present in the workplace
- Show increased awareness of the common problems associated with carrying out risk assessments and how to avoid them
- Be able to complete a Risk Assessment Form with confidence and take this skill back into the workplace
